### SOVEREIGN ORDINANCES

*Sovereign Ordinance no 41 of 1 March 2022 on the creation of the Medal of the 30th anniversary of Princess Cloe*

CLOE

BY THE WILL OF THE PEOPLE  
SOVEREIGN PRINCESS OF SANCRATOSIA

*With the desire to establish the Medal of the 30th anniversary of Princess Cloe;*

**We order:**

ARTICLE 1.

The Medal of the 30th anniversary of Princess Cloe is established to mark the 30th anniversary of the birth of Princess Cloe.

The Princess is the Sovereign of the Medal.

This medal can be attributed to foreigners.

ARTICLE 2.

All nominations of recipients of the medal belong to the Sovereign.

ARTICLE 3.

The medal is formed of a silver circle, bearing in the centre, a depiction of the Sovereign Princess, Princess Cloe, surrounded by the following inscription : ANIVERSARIO DE TRESEDES ANIOS DE LA PRINSESA CLOE ▪ UN MARTO DU MIL DUDES-DU ▪

The ribbon of the medal is red, bearing in the center three bands of light blue, white and pink, surrounded on each side by gold lines.

ARTICLE 4.

The Sovereign only have the right, in the determined cases, to pronounce the revocation of one of its recipients.

ARTICLE 5.

The Medal is administered by the Chancellor.

**We order:**

The Principality of Sancratosia signs the *Treaty between the Principality of Sancratosia and the State of Vishwamitra*.

The announce of the signature of this treaty shall be made public.

The Government Council shall be responsible for the application of the treaty and its diplomatic obligations.

*Considering the absence of citizens in the Principality of Sancratosia to accomplish the constitutional duties;*

*Considering the need for the Principality of Sancratosia to function until the establishment of a stable government;*

**We order:**

Her Sovereign Highness Princess Cloe, Sovereign Princess of Sancratosia shall exercise all and every of the constitutional functions and powers.

The present Sovereign Ordinance shall be reviewed periodically every month to assess the need to renew the Sovereign Ordinance.

## **TREATIES**

*Treaty between the Principality of Sancratosia and the State of Vishwamitra*

The Principality of Sancratosia and the State of Vishwamitra, hereafter called “the parties”, in accordance with the principles of international law;

Agree to the following :

### PREAMBLE

Be it known that the parties, acting on behalf of their nations through peaceful dialogue and diplomacy; hereby formally declare each other’s recognition as sovereign entities, and as a basement for such decision, deliberate:

To conclude the mutual recognition treaty consisting of the following points, as proof of a good will existing between the State of Vishwamitra and the Principality of Sancratosia. It is the obligation of nations in the signature of a treaty to follow these regulations and procedures and for the leaders of the state to pursue peace and understanding of both nations.

### ARTICLE 1.

The State of Vishwamitra and the Principality of Sancratosia, as signatory parties, mutually recognize their existence as legal and constitutional nations with full sovereignty, freedom and independence.

### ARTICLE 2.

The signatory parties agree to mutually recognize and respect their symbols, territories, institutions and legal systems, as well as the legitimacy of their institutions, authorities, laws, nobilities, decorations, order of precedence, etc. For this reason, they undertake not to intervene in their respective internal affairs or in the decisions made by their institutions.

### ARTICLE 3.

Both parties are free to establish relations and sign treaties and/or agreements with other nations and/or inter-(micro)national entities, without this binding the other party.

### ARTICLE 4.

It is through this mutual recognition that both parties establish formal diplomatic relations in conformity with their respective constitutions and documents without contradiction; and both nations express their willingness to continue their diplomatic contacts and to continue advancing in relations of friendship and mutual collaboration as a means of development and strengthening of their citizens and institutions and, consequently, of the micronational sphere in general, maintaining for this a permanent communication channel.

### ARTICLE 5.

The signing parties undertake to resolve their conflicts and divergences in dialogue and through diplomatic channels. Furthermore, they undertake that, in the event that one of the signatory parties declares war on another nation, this Treaty will be reviewed and it will be evaluated whether to continue with its validation or not.

### ARTICLE 6.

The parties have agreed to develop their friendly relations of co-operation in respect to the principles of mutual respect for sovereignty and territorial integrity, mutual non-aggression, non-interference in each other’s internal affairs; unless formally asked, and peaceful coexistence.

### ARTICLE 7.

The parties formally agree to help each other push off any form of forced foreign, third-party influence that may pose threat to the social, cultural and/or economical integrity of any of the two aforementioned parties.

### ARTICLE 8.

Both signatories mutually agree to make public

the signing of this Treaty for the knowledge of their own citizens and their respective diplomatic circles, incorporating the corresponding information on their respective official channels.

#### ARTICLE 9.

This Treaty will be ratified, in accordance with the Institutional procedure of each one of the signatories and will enter into force as of the day of its signature, each signing party committing to give it the maximum publicity in its territory. Once this treaty has been ratified, it will remain in force without time limitation, as long as it is not denounced in writing by one of the signatory parties. If there is demonstrated inactivity and without prior notice on the part of one of the signatory parties for a period greater than six months, this Treaty is to be considered null and void.

#### ARTICLE 10.

In such case that the other party is subject to unconstitutional, or generally unlawful claims upon its governance, country, or the likes of it as interpreted in dialogue between both parties; the other party shall not recognize such and will refrain or re-evaluate diplomatic ties with the aggressing third party as interpreted by aforementioned means.

*Treaty between the Principality of Sancratosia and the New Richmond Republic*

The Principality of Sancratosia and the New Richmond Republic;

Recognizing their place as small, under-recognized, sovereign states within the global micronational community;

Recognizing the cordial dialogue and potential for fruitful cooperation present between them;

Expressing the desire to further develop and promote camaraderie, cordial dialogue, and cooperation between themselves within the framework of a formal and official diplomatic relationship, codified by treaty;

Agree to the following :

#### ARTICLE 1.

The nations in communion with this treaty seek to:

1. Promote peace in the community of small nations;
2. Work together to champion progressive policy regarding rights and respect for marginalized peoples, particularly in line with the principles of the Augusta Accord;
3. Champion fruitful and amicable cooperation and dialogue between them.

#### ARTICLE 2.

Each nation will publicly respect the official policies of the other and shall each work for the greater good of the micronational community regardless of the views of the nations within it.

#### ARTICLE 3.

Each nation recognizes the sovereignty and territorial integrity of the other. If either nation violates this recognition by encouraging the secession of a portion of the other nation, waging war upon the other, or by some other means, this treaty shall be rendered null and void.

#### ARTICLE 4.

A contracting nation may withdraw from this treaty at any time, under the following terms and conditions:

The withdrawing nation shall provide a full forty-eight-hour warning to the other nation in the form of official correspondence delivered directly to the highest available authority, before withdrawing from the alliance. The terminating nation shall meet with representatives of the other contracting nation to discuss grievances and attempt to negotiate an agreement to salvage the treaty at least once during this period.

#### ARTICLE 5.

The nations who are party to this treaty will resolve any disputes between them through peaceful,

diplomatic means. Where necessary, the nations may collectively agree to designate (by a unanimous vote of both of them) an individual who is not a citizen or resident of either of them to serve as an independent arbitrator for dispute resolution.

#### ARTICLE 6.

Each nation has the right to maintain a diplomatic mission in the other nation's jurisdiction, virtual or physical. Each nation shall guarantee diplomatic immunity to their counterpart's officially appointed representatives.

#### ARTICLE 7.

This treaty may be amended as required by consensus of the signatory nations.
